Last Workshop on 11th of June 2011:

- 1. The fabric is on the inboard bays of the first (LH) wing and shrunk to 250 degrees.**
- 2. The aileron Trailing edge cove appears to be a poor fit for the repaired ribs in that area and will need to be replaced.**
- 3. Some of the items on the fuselage “to-do list’ have been done.**

Next Workshop on 18th of June 2011:

- 1. The emphasis will be on: shrunk**
- 2. Getting the fabric on the first wing fully shrunk.**
- 3. Applying brush on the first wing**
- 4. Marking the wing for the rib lacing.**
