Last Workshop on August 8th:

- 1. The fitting of the leading edges progressed to the layout stage for the screw holes and discovery that the new LE blanks taper end to end to allow for the overlap (ship-lapping).**
- 2. The elevator and rudder cables previously (partially) built were wrouded thru the fuselage and the cable assembly (two cables and chain plus a turnbuckle) were started.**
- 3. There was the usual fine food and flying and special treat was a group of 15-20 vintage and classic motorcycles that visited. They were impressed enough that they have decided to start a motorcycle restoration project to attract new members!**

- 5. Placing the fuselage on a sturdier (wood) support.**
